When an opportunity became available at Waitt Radio Networks in Omaha as a Music Director, Polychronopolis jumped at the chance. “I wanted to get back to the Midwest and hone my skills. I was quickly promoted to Program Director of Waitt’s Modern Rock format and spent two great years there. It was a great experience, but getting back behind the microphone and on one of the top rated stations in the Midwest is a huge homerun,” said Polychronopolis about the new post at Q. “I’ve been a huge fan of Q for years and this is an opportunity of a lifetime.” Polychronopolis can now be heard weekdays from 1:00pm-6:00pm and on Sunday evenings from 8:00pm-10:00pm for Q’s popular “Ultra Modern Show,” a program dedicated to cutting edge new music, selected specifically by Polychronopolis and Dane.

KQKQ Program Director Nevin Dane moved up his timeslot up to 10am-1pm with the addition of Polychronopolis to the lineup. “I think this is the best way to maximize our on-air talent,” he stated. The KQKQ weekday lineup includes PAT and JT in the Morning, Dane in MIDDAYS, Polychronopolis in Afternoons and Heather Lee on evenings.
